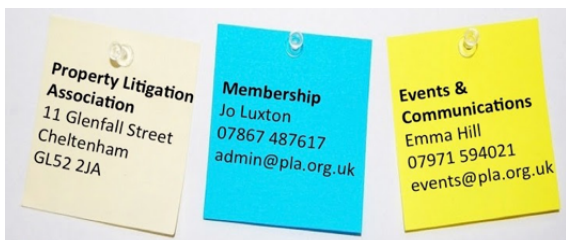


PLA 2020 AGM
